

# Choices Cards



## Card 1

You can't have your party at the arcade like you wanted to because it's too expensive for that many people. What do you choose next?

- Have the party in your backyard. Read Card 3.
- Switch to inviting just your five best friends. Read Card 2.

## Card 2

You can have the party at the arcade like you wanted! You can invite only five people, but there are six you really want to invite.

- What do you choose next?
- Leave out the next-door neighbor you've been kind-of good friends with since you were 3. Read Card 4.
  - Switch to inviting the whole class. Read Card 1.
  - Leave out a friend from your soccer team. Read Card 5.

## Card 3

Choose which event you want at your backyard party:

- Pony rides. Read Card 6.
- Bouncy house. Read Card 7.

## Card 4

Your neighbor sees your friends arriving to head to the arcade and asks what's going on. What do you choose next?

- Tell her you're sorry, it's your birthday party and you wanted to invite her but there were limited spaces. Read Card 8.
- Tell her it's a church event so she doesn't have her feelings hurt. Read Card 9.

## Card 5

You find out he's never been invited to a party. What do you choose next?

- Leave out your next-door neighbor instead. Read Card 4.
- Leave him out anyway and try to make sure he doesn't find out about the party. Read Card 10.

## Card 6

You find out your best friend is allergic to ponies after you've sent out your invitations that say there will be pony rides. What do you choose next?

- Switch from pony rides to a bouncy house, even though your classmates are excited about the pony. Read Card 7.
- Keep the pony even though your best friend can't come. Read Card 11.

## Card 7

Your best friend breaks her arm jumping in the bouncy house, just 10 minutes into the party. What do you choose next?

- End the party early to be with your best friend. Read Card 12.
- Keep the party going, but wish your friend the best as she heads to the hospital. Read Card 11.

## Card 8

She's mad that she's the one you left out. What do you choose next?

- Make it up to her by planning a fun day for just the two of you. Read Card 14.
- Get mad at her for her not understanding that space was limited. Read Card 15.

## Card 9

Now if you ever invite her to church again, she may ask someone about the arcade day and find out you lied. What do you choose next?

- Never invite her to your church. Read card 16.
- Tell her the truth later so you can invite her to your church. Read Card 17.

## Card 10

You notice him getting sadder and sadder at soccer practices, and eventually he quits the team. What do you choose next?

- You invite him to a church event. Read Card 17.
- You get in touch with him to ask why he quit the team. Read Card 13.

## Card 11

Your best friend is mad at you, and your friendship slowly breaks apart. But you made other friends by inviting classmates you didn't know that well to your party.

## Card 12

Your whole class is mad at you because your party ended so soon, but your best friend is glad you're with her.

## Card 13

He tells you he feels like a loser and that no one likes him, but you say you really enjoy spending time with him. You start spending more time together and become best friends!

## Card 14

During your fun day together, you're able to tell her about Jesus. She starts a friendship with Jesus.

## Card 15

You both stay mad and drift apart as friends.

## Card 16

She feels like you don't want her to be a part of your life anymore, and you drift apart as friends.

## Card 17

Your friend comes to church and starts a friendship with Jesus.
