## Choices Cards

## Card 1

You can't have your party at the arcade like you wanted to because it's too expensive for that many people. What do you choose next?

- Have the party in your backyard. Read Card 3.
- Switch to inviting just your five best friends. Read Card 2.


## Card 4

Your neighbor sees your friends arriving to head to the arcade and asks what's going on. What do you choose next?

- Tell her you're sorry, it's your birthday party and you wanted to invite her but there were limited spaces. Read Card 8.
- Tell her it's a church event so she doesn't have her feelings hurt. Read Card 9.


## Card 2

You can have the party at the arcade like you wanted! You can invite only five people, but there are six you really want to invite.
What do you choose next?

- Leave out the next-door neighbor you've been kind-of good friends with since you were 3. Read Card 4.
- Switch to inviting the whole class. Read Card 1.
- Leave out a friend from your soccer team. Read Card 5.


## Card 5

You find out he's never been invited to a party. What do you choose next?

- Leave out your next-door neighbor instead. Read Card 4.
- Leave him out anyway and try to make sure he doesn't find out about the party. Read Card 10.


## Card 3

Choose which event you want at your backyard party:

- Pony rides. Read Card 6.
- Bouncy house. Read Card 7.


## Card 6

You find out your best friend is allergic to ponies after you've sent out your invitations that say there will be pony rides. What do you choose next?

- Switch from pony rides to a bouncy house, even though your classmates are excited about the pony. Read Card 7.
- Keep the pony even though your best friend can't come. Read Card 11.


## Card 9

Now if you ever invite her to church again, she may ask someone about the arcade day and find out you lied. What do you choose next?

- Never invite her to your church. Read card 16.
- Tell her the truth later so you can invite her to your church. Read Card 17.
